The new Lumding College website features:

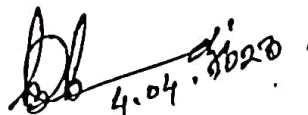

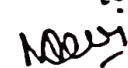

6. Roles and Responsibilities:

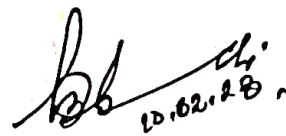
- Responsibilities were assigned to IT Cell members:

Feedback and Response

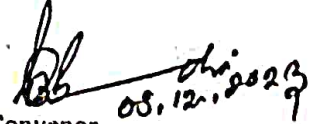
