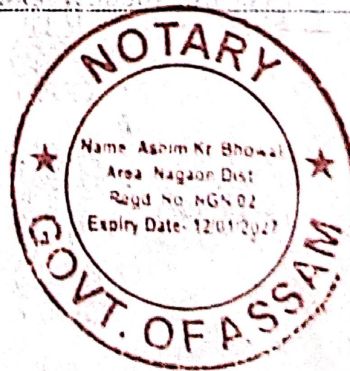

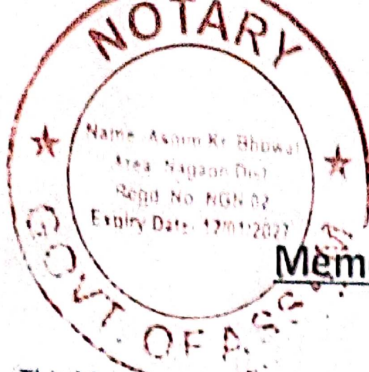
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Memorandum of Understanding

This Memorandum of Understanding (hereinafter called MOU) is entered into on this day September 25th 2023 at Lanka, Assam.

Between

Dalmia Bharat Foundation, a non-profit making organization registered under the Indian Trust Act, 1882 having its Registered office at 12th Floor, Hansalaya Building, 15 Barakhamba Road, New Delhi 110001, which is implementing Skill Development programs across India.

And

Lumding College, a college affiliated under the Gauhati University and having its Registered office at College Road, Near Lumding Post Office, Lumding, Dist - Hojai, Assam - 782447, which expression shall include the successors and assigns of the Second Part (hereinafter called as Lumding College);

The parties mentioned above shall be jointly referred to as "Parties" under this MOU.

1. Purpose of the MOU

This MOU is Intended to establish a two-party framework for providing skill training to students of LUMDING COLLEGE by DALMIA BHARAT FOUNDATION under the Skill Development programme.

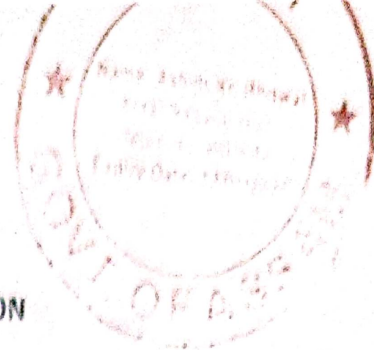
1. Dalmia Bharat Foundation will train the students provided by LUMDING COLLEGE in Entrepreneurship Development & Soft Skill.

2.1: - Responsibilities of DALMIA BHARAT FOUNDATION

A- DALMIA BHARAT FOUNDATION will ensure to provide quality training and also will provide job assistance on completion of training to the students in their premises.

B- DALMIA BHARAT FOUNDATION will provide with required resource person for One /Two Day Entrepreneurship Development workshop organised by the LUMDING COLLEGE authority in the college premises.

D- DALMIA BHARAT FOUNDATION will provide certificates to all the students on completion of the training along with placement assistance.

2.2: Responsibilities of LUMDING COLLEGE

A. LUMDING COLLEGE will give proper counseling to the students regarding the training to be held at DALMIA BHARAT FOUNDATION.

B. LUMDING COLLEGE will ensure to provide minimum 20 candidates/Batch.

C. LUMDING COLLEGE will be responsible for mobilization of suitable students for the said training.

G. It shall be the responsibility of LUMDING COLLEGE to bear the Training cost of Rs.5000/- per candidate upon completion of admission process of the candidates.

4. Address for Communication

4.1. Formal communications shall include communication by email as well.

5. Confidentiality

5.1. Both parties acknowledge the confidentiality of information that may be shared provided among the parties from time to time, under this MoU. Both parties agree not to disclose the same to any outside party, unless such information is,

- (i) Part of the public domain at the time of disclosure or
- (ii) Require to be disclosed in accordance with the applicable laws of the country.

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6. Arbitration and Applicable laws -

6.1. The parties hereby agree that any dispute arising in connection with this MoU shall first be addressed mutually by conciliation between the Parties. If the said Parties are unable to resolve the dispute mutually, the dispute shall be referred to a sole Arbitrator appointed under the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996 whose decision shall be final and binding on all parties.

6.2. In case an aggrieved party seeks judicial remedy, the petition shall be filed within the jurisdiction of Delhi High Court.

7. Force Majeure-

7.1. No failure or omission by any of the parties to perform any of the terms and conditions under this MOU shall give rise to any claim against such party or be deemed breach of this MOU if such failure or omission arises from an act of God, war or military operations, national or local emergency, natural disasters (fire, lightning, flood or such similar disasters), or any other reason which lies outside the control of the Parties.

8. Validity of the MOU

This MOU shall come into force on September 1, 2023 and shall be valid for 1 year and MOU will be renewed post validity period on mutual agreement between the two parties.

9. Effect of invalidity of any clause of MoU on validity of MoU.

The invalidity of any provision of this MOU shall not invalidate other provisions or the MOU. Any such gap should be duly modified through amendment to the MOU in writing, with mutual consultation among all the parties.

10. Not an agent of other

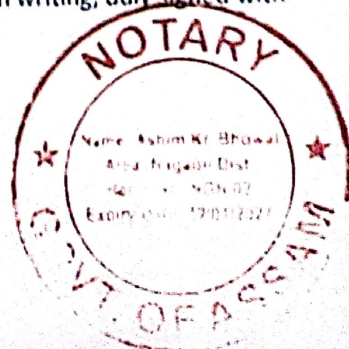
