Title of the Practice: Participation to beat COVID-19

Goal:

Further, to involve in 'Vaccine as birthday gift campaign' by extending financial support to Assam Arogya Nidhi during of second wave of COVID-19 pandemic.

The Context:

Being considered as national duty some faculties are actively involved in Covid duty as ordered by District Disaster Management, Hojai. To get rid from such pandemic, it is quite necessary for mass vaccinations which require huge funds.

The Practice:

To fulfil the responsibility of the good citizens, teaching and non-teaching community of Lumding College extends hands and participated in "Each One Reach One" COVID Mission. Faculty members and students contributed their valuable services to the COVID patients, their family members during pandemic. As a responsible citizen, the employees of Lumding College donate one day's salary from the month of May, 2021 to Assam Arogya Nidhi to support 'Vaccine as birthday gift campaign' during COVID-19 second wave.

Evidence of Success:

The programme was successful as the teaching and non-teaching staff of Lumding College whole heartedly supported the State Government appeal by contributing one day's salary to Assam Arogya Nidhi. Some stakeholders of Lumding College actively engaged in Lumding Coble team to participate in "Each One Reach One" COVID Mission. Problems encountered and Resources Required:

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Best practice No. 2

Title of the Practice: 'Health and hygiene'

Goal:

The main aim of the practice is to generate awareness about Health and Hygiene among the student's community and students in particular and to create awareness about health. The programme was supported by Assam Science and Environmental Council as a part of awareness programme under 'SANSKER: MANUH MANUHOR BABE'. To comply with this the Women Cell of ACTA Unit of Lumding College has organised on the selected topic on 3rd December, 2021.



The Context:

Nowadays society in general and community in particular are not fully aware of the good practices of health and hygiene. As a result, they easily fell victim of numbers of hazardous diseases. They even do not know about hygienic food and other healthy practices. In order to create awareness among the students coming from various communities and in greater interests of the society in particular the programme was organized.

The Practice:

To meet our social responsibility towards the students of the college and nearby community, an attempt was made under the Women Cell, ACTA, Lumding College to create a general awareness amongst the people of neighboring area. The scheme 'SANSKER: MANUH MANUHOR BABE' has been undertaken by the Govt. of Assam with a view to eradicate misconception of the society mainly among the rural folk and slum areas and to cultivate a new vive of positive awareness among the masses. The cell chooses Navarun High School, Lumding, as their venue. The programme was graced by the presence of Dr. Mawsumi Bhattacharjee of Lumding FRU. Dr. Bhattacharjee enlightened the audience by her expertise deliberations.

Evidence of Success:

The programme was successful as quite a number of students, teachers and people from around the locality gathered the venue. Members of the Women Cell, ACTA of Lumding College discussed the purpose of the meeting and awareness programme. Dr. Mawsumi Bhattacharjee, the resource person presented a brief talk about the selected theme in her enlightened deliberations emphasizing on mental, semi-mental as well as physical health among the students in general and community in particular. She also talked about the use of cell phones by school students. Her mesmerizing speech is an eye opener for the audience. In course of her deliberations she also discussed on mensural circles among the school going girls and associated taboos prevailing in the society, proper disposal of sanitary napkins, abuse of drug etc. Active participation from our students and ex- students and local people made the programme a success.

Problems encountered and Resources Required:

The programme on Health and Hygiene need more space to cover up. Though the programme was attended by many people of the locality including the students of the College, but the programme felt the necessity of more gathering so that there will be a mass awareness. NGO and other organisations

should work with the Women Cell, ACTA, Lumding College to create more awareness on such social issues.

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
