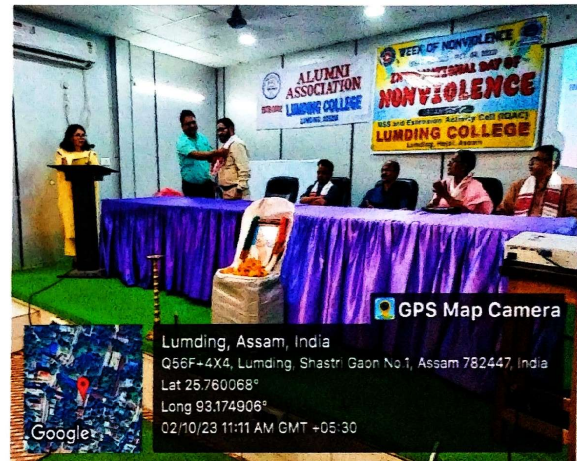




Report on Observance of "Week of Nonviolence"

In pursuance of the letter from the Office of the District Commissioner, Hojai (eCF No. 38424/DFA/108324 dated 13-09-23) regarding observance of International Day of Non-violence, a weeklong programme was organised in Lumding College by the NSS and Extension Activity Cell, Lumding College in association with Yuva Tourism Club, Lumding College and Lumding College Alumni Association. A number of programme was organised to observe "Week of Nonviolence" (September 29 to October 04). On 29th September 2023 an online Essay Writing Competition on the Topic "Nonviolence movement" was organised. The language for the competition was Assamese, English, Bengali and Hindi. On 30th September 2023 one online Drawing Competition was held on the theme- "Nonviolence movement". Further on 30th September and 1st October, Swachhata Abhiyan were also organised in the college campus for a pivotal cleanliness initiative as advocated by the Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi Ji who had urged citizens to join the Shramdaan, a cleanliness initiative as part of Swachh Bharat on 1st October 2023 at 10 AM i.e. 'Ek Tareekh-Ek Ghanta- Ek Saath Abhiyan. 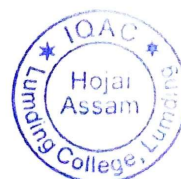

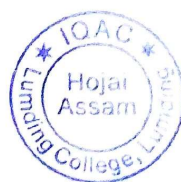


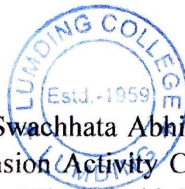
Distribution of Prizes by Dignitaries
