**Report of extension and outreach Programmes conducted by the institution during the
year 1st August, 2022 to 31st July, 2023**

From time to time the college organizes extension activities like awareness programmes, blood donation camps, free medical camp and other community development programmes in order to promote a meaningful and sustained rapport between the college and the community. These activities are meant for application of the knowledge acquired in classrooms by the students in real life situations. As such the impact of these activities have been manifold. The students through these activities become more aware of their social roles and responsibilities. Going beyond just acquiring bookish knowledge within the four walls of the institution, these activities provide the students with opportunities to serve the community which in turn sensitizes them to various social issues and help in their holistic development. These activities also help the students in developing a selfless service-mindedness. The college therefore, through various cells and units, have organized timely service centric programmes in order to keep students socially responsible and aware along with being academically competent.

The NSS and Extension activity Cell and Women Cell of the ACTA unit, Lumding College take part in various initiatives like rural education, cleanliness and hygiene by organizes lecture programmes, workshops for students inside and outside of the college which is helpful for them to cope up with the community. Women Cell of the ACTA unit, Lumding College in each year observe the International Women's Day by inviting some eminent personalities as resource person to deliver lecture in the field of gender sensitivity and other issues. The Environment and Climate Cell of the college works towards promoting the ethics of preservation and protection of our green environment. The Women cell of the ACTA unit, Lumding College and some departments also donated stationeries, books, sports materials to neighbouring school children on different occasions.

Some of the activities during the year 2022-23 are enlisted below-

1. NSS and Extension Activity Cell, Lumding College and NSS Unit volunteers actively participated in the Training Programme for verifying the State Govts. Scheme of Orunodoi which was held on **02-08-2022** in the college seminar hall. Later on, the selected NSS Volunteers participated in the verifying process. **Total Students Participants = 105**
2. NSS and Extension Activity Cell, Lumding College and NSS Unit volunteers actively participated in the Har Ghar Tiranga Campaign and they organise street drama on **11-08-2022** for creating awareness and to create buzz among common citizen with specific call to action on buying/hoisting of Tiranga during 13th - 15th August/gifting a flag. **Total Students Participants = 28**
3. Cultural and Literary Activities Committee, IQAC and Women Cell, ACTA unit of the college in association with NSS and Extension Activity Cell, Lumding College had organised Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsav during **10th to 15th August, 2022**. **Total Students Participants = 125**



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4. NSS and Extension Activity Cell, Lumding College had organised special assembly in connection with International Youth Day on **12-08-2022**. **Total Students Participants = 97**
5. Lumding College Students Union and NSS Volunteers had celebrated the Raksha Bandhan on **12th August 2022** and they visited Bharat Sevashram Sangha boys Hostel and Local Police station to tie each other 'rakhis' to celebrate brotherhood and togetherness. **Total Students Participants = 25**
6. On the fifth day of celebration of 'Azadi ka Amrit Mahotsav', as directed by the government of India to provide free precaution dose at government vaccination centers, a vaccination camp was organized by the NSS and Extension Activity Cell, IQAC, Lumding College in collaboration with Lumding FRU, on **14th August, 2022** at Lumding College. One office assistant and two staff nurses arrived at the college from Lumding FRU for the vaccination drive. Before starting the drive, they were felicitated duly by the student union and faculty members of the college. Faculties and 34 students participated in the programme. **Total Students Participants = 28**
7. As India celebrated its 76th Independence Day this year, Lumding College too observed the day with great pomp and show with a series of events being lined up for the day. This year, **15th of August** was also the last day of the celebration for Lumding College after a 6 days long observance of 'Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsav' as initiated and directed by the Government of India to commemorate 75 glorious years of India's independence. Tiranga rally began at 8.00 a.m. in which NSS cadets, students, faculties and non-teaching staffs carried 75 feet long Tiranga over their head from the college to the Swahid Maidan via Main Bazar, Lumding to mark the 75 years of independence. In the Swahid Maidan, NSS cadets of Lumding College took part in the central parade for the first time, where the national flag was hoisted by the local governance. **Total Students Participants = 200**
8. Campus Cleanliness Committee and NSS & Extension Activity Cell IQAC Lumding college observed the "Swachhata Pakhwada 2022", from 1st September 2022 to 15th September 2022 by conducting Swachatta Abhiyan in the campus, awareness meetings on Swachatta, awareness on banning plastic, awareness on health and hygiene, Tabaco free campus and collecting plastic in the campus and neighboring streets. On **15th September 2022**, the fortnight long programme was ended by taking a Sankalp for Swachatta of the Campus and an awareness meeting organized among the students and faculties. The awareness programme on Swachatta Abhiyan "Swachhata Pakhwada 2022" is held in the College premises wherein the IQAC Coordinator, Dr. S. K. Das, Ms. Gitanjali Nath, Convener of Campus Cleanliness Committee and Sri Anjan Paul, Convenor of NSS and Extension Activity Cell, IQAC deliver speech on Swachatta. NSS volunteers and members of Campus Cleanliness Committee and Faculty members of NSS and Extension Activity Cell IQAC attend the awareness programme. **Total Students Participants = 29**
9. A blood donation camp with the theme 'Know about HIV' was organized in Lumding College, Lumding on **24th September 2022**. It was organized by the Red Ribbon Club (RRC) and NSS & Extension Activity Cell (NSS Unit), Lumding College in association with Assam State AIDS Control Society and Assam State Blood Transfusion Council. Medical professionals from Nagaon



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Civil Hospital extended their services during the blood donation drive. NSS volunteers, along with students and faculty members, participated throughout the session. Forms were distributed to individuals, who filled them out before donating blood. All the preparations such as arrangement of beds, sanitation, etc. were made. Two teachers, Mr. Shaleh Akram and Mr. Biswajit Nath along with 13 students donated their blood. **Total Students Participants =35**

10. A cleanliness programme was organised by the NSS and Extension Activity Cell, Lumding College in collaboration with the Cleanliness Committee of Lumding College, Lumding on **22nd October 2022**. The programme is an initiative of the country-wide campaign, Swachh Bharat Mission or Clean India Mission initiated by the Government of India on 2nd October 2014 to eliminate open defecation and improve solid waste management and to create Open Defecation Free (ODF) villages. The theme of this year is "Clean India Safe India". **Total Students Participants =24**
11. In pursuance of the letter no. DHE/PA/Misc/0/2022 dated 26th October, 2022, from the Director of Higher Education, Kahilipara, Guwahati to organize a 'Unity Run' in all the districts of Assam to commemorate the birth anniversary of Sardar Vallabhbhai Patel on **31st of October 2022** which is celebrated as Rashtriya Ekta Divas across the country, Lumding College organized the said Unity run in coordination with the District Administration on the said day. The NSS & Extension Activity Cell, Cultural Heritage Cell and Sports Committee of Lumding College extended their full cooperation and support in successfully organizing and implementing the event. **Total Students Participants = 40**
12. In an endeavour to bridge the gap between academia and rural India while addressing pressing development challenges, a comprehensive field survey was organized by the NSS and the Extension Activity Cell of Lumding College. This three-day survey took place from the **12th to 14th of November 2022**, encompassing three villages: Shashtri Gaon 1, Shashtri Gaon 2, and Potupathar located in the Lumding region. The survey was conducted under the auspices of the Unnat Bharat Abhiyan, a scheme initiated by the Central Government of India. The Unnat Bharat Abhiyan is a transformative initiative with a mission to facilitate higher educational institutions' engagement with rural communities in identifying development challenges and devising sustainable solutions for fostering inclusive growth. **Total Students Participants = 118**
13. UGC and District Administration instructed to observe the Samvidhan Divas. Samvidhan Divas is celebrated in India on **26th November** every year to commemorate the adoption of the Constitution of India. The Indian democracy marching ahead in its 75th year, on the strengths of inclusiveness and diversity, is not only the world's largest democracy but also the mother of democracy. Department of Political Science and NSS and the Extension Activity Cell of Lumding College had organised the programme. **Total Students Participants = 63**
14. As announced by the State Election Commission of Assam, Electoral Literacy Club, Lumding College in association with District Administration, Hojai, organized a Voters' Awareness Camp on **01/12/2022** at the library hall of Lumding College. The programme was attended by Election Officer of Hojai District, Mr. Subodh Chakraborty, DRP of Hojai, Principal of the college, Dr. Mrinal Kanti Paul, IQAC coordinator, Dr. Sanjay Kanti Das and Ms. Chandrawali Goswami, Asst.



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Professor from the Department of Political Science. Students, teaching as well as non-teaching staff, Booth Level Officers and Booth Level Supervisors were also present in the programme.

15. The year 2022 marks the 400th birth anniversary of the legendary general of Ahom kingdom Lachit Barphukan. The whole state of Assam is celebrating this historic moment with great pomp and show. Lumding College, too, is observing this remarkable year with zeal. In the line with this, Cleanliness Committee, IQAC, Lumding College organised a cleanliness drive in the college premise on **08-09-2022**. The program started at 7.30 a.m. in which about 30 participants, including members of Lumding College Students' Union, NSS volunteers, teaching and non-teaching staffs of the college participated. **Total Students Participants = 30**

The event witnessed the presence of esteemed guests who added value to the program with their insights and expertise. **Total Students Participants = 39**
17. Like every year, this year too, on the **23rd of January**, members of NSS Unit, Lumding College along with Netaji club special parade group, Bharat Scouts, Hindustan Scouts and students of Gurukul High School, participated in the Lumding rally which was organized by Netaji Club, Kalibari, Lumding. It was a tribute to Netaji on his 126th birth anniversary. Other dignitaries who attended the programme include Honorable MLA of Lumding, Mr. Shibu Misra and other respected members of the club. **Total Students Participants = 36**
18. On **25th January, 2023**, National Voters' Day was observed at Lumding College. The Electoral Literacy Club, Lumding College takes the initiative to organise the function. This day is observed to encourage more young voters to take part in the political process. Government of India pronounced to celebrate January 25 every year as "National Voters' Day". It had been started from 25th January 2011 to mark the foundation day of Election Commission of India. **Total Students Participants = 16**
19. The NSS volunteers of Lumding College participated in the Republic Day parade on **26/01/2023** held at Swahid Maidan, Lumding wherein the Republic Day program was observed centrally. The Hon'ble MLA Shibu Misra attended the program and hoisted the tiranga. Many other school students also participated in the parade; many dignitaries delivered speeches on the occasion followed by cultural programs. **Total Students Participants = 23**
20. The MSME Acceleration Trade and Commerce Conclave 2023 was held on **17th February 2023** at Neberubuli Field, Nagaon which was organized by the Industries, Commerce and Public Enterprise Department, Government of Assam. Final-year students in their sixth semester from the Economics department of Lumding College, accompanied by their mentor Mr. Arvind Medhi, Assistant Professor in the same department, attended this conclave. The students gained valuable



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insights from real-world business scenarios and had the opportunity to network with industry professionals. Additionally, they were informed about the UDYAM portal, also known as MSME Registration, which involves government authentication along with a Recognition Certificate and a Unique Number. This registration is crucial for certifying the legality and operation of small or medium businesses or enterprises. **Total Students Participants = 06**

The drive aims at cleaning the *Gutkha* strains from the campus and spreading awareness against the use of *Gutkha* among the students. This medical camp was aimed at doing basic health check- up of the village members in Shastri Gaon 1. The NSS unit of the college including teacher members, NSS program officers and student volunteers arrived at Shastri Gaon LP school at 11:30 am. They were accompanied by Dr. Tarhir Hussain and three nurses from Lumding Civil hospital. The gaon burha also attended the program. Before the health check-up began, Mr. Anjan Paul, NSS program coordinator welcomed the medical team and also stated the objectives of the event. **Total Students Participants = 92**
23. Environment and Climate Cell, Lumding College in association with ASTEC, Assam had conducted a weeklong programme on LiFE- Lifestyle for environment from **22nd March 2023 to 28th March, 2023**. Faculties and students participated in this extension Programme. **Total Students Participants = 111**
24. An awareness camp on Women Health and Hygiene along with the distribution of sanitary kits was jointly organized by the NSS and Women Cell, ACTA unit, Lumding College and Helping Hands Foundation, an NGO in Lumding on **28th March 2023** at Photopathar, Lumding. **Total Students Participants = 59**
25. Volunteers of NSS Unit participated in the North East NSS Festival 2023 at Gauhati University on **31-03-2023 to 04-04-2023**. **Total Students Participants = 02**
26. A cleanliness drive as organised by NSS and Extension Activity Cell, IQAC, Lumding College in the college premise on **April 13, 2023**. The drive mainly aimed at cleaning the front part of the college, including the Rabindranath Tagore statue and the college gate. The drive started at 9.00 AM in the morning, in which 10 faculties and 75 students took part. Lastly, the team covers the Sitalabari Mela premises and collected the waste. It was a part of Swachh Bharat mission, a Govt. of India initiative to make India clean and hygienic. **Total Students Participants = 12**
27. Observance of World Earth Day 2023 on 22-04-2023 and Massive Plantation drive during **22-04-2023 to 25-04-2023**, by NSS and Extension Activity Cell, IQAC and Dept of Geology & Botany. **Total Students Participants = 39+108 = 147**
28. On **31st May 2023**, NSS & Extension Activity Cell, Lumding College had organised “World No Tobacco Day” in the college seminar hall at 11.30Am. This year’s theme is “Grow food, not



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tobacco”. The 2023 global campaign aims to raise awareness about alternative crop production and marketing opportunities for tobacco farmers and encourage them to grow sustainable, nutritious crops. It will also aim to expose the tobacco industry’s efforts to interfere with attempts to substitute tobacco growing with sustainable crops, thereby contributing to the global food crisis.

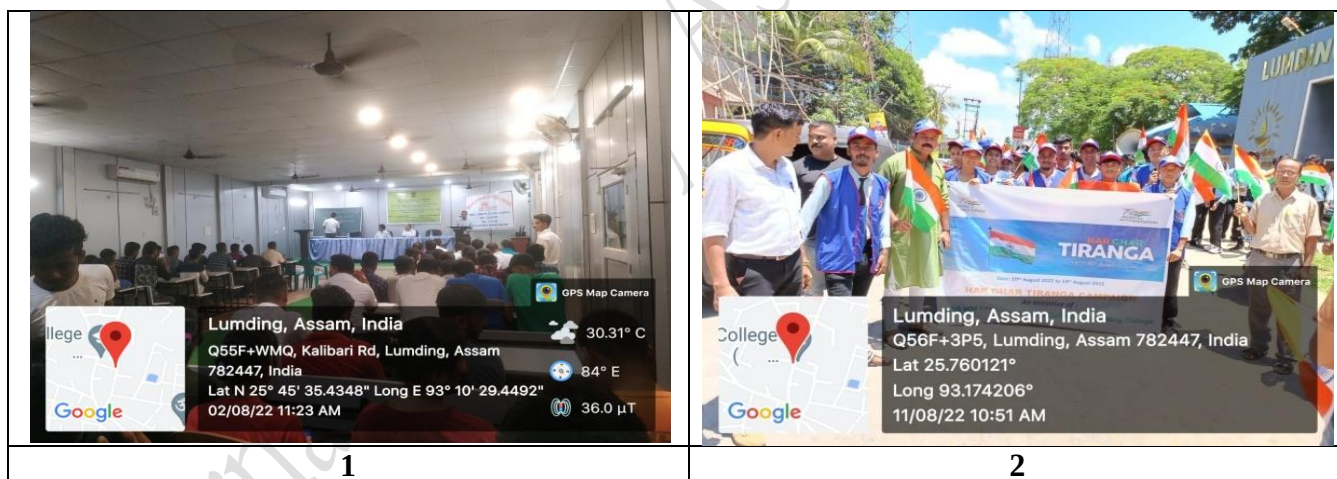
